#### **Buckeye Road Trip**

The Buckeye Road trip is a reduced-cost busing service designed to bring students to cities in and out of Ohio. These cities currently include Cleveland, Cincinnati, Toledo, Chicago, Pittsburgh, Philadelphia and New York City.

This spring break, buses will leave campus on Friday, March 10 and will return on Sunday, March 19. All costs associated with the trip are non-refundable. Round-trip costs are \$25 for trips to Cleveland, Cincinnati, Toledo and Pittsburgh and \$65 for trips to Philadelphia, Chicago and New York City. You may choose to travel only one way, but the cost will be the same.
