FAFSA and Special Scholarships

FAFSA**

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the Special Scholarships Application are now open for students and families to complete for the 2022-2023 academic year.

Every student is highly encouraged to file the FAFSA to be considered for the most financial aid (including scholarships, grants, loans and Federal Work-Study). Students and families must file the FAFSA each year. The FAFSA became available on October 1 and Ohio State's priority date for filing is February 1. You can still submit your FAFSA after that date, but filing before will give your family priority aid consideration.

The university offers hundreds of special-eligibility scholarships with a wide variety of eligibility criteria. To apply each year, you must file the FAFSA and the Special Scholarships Application by the priority date of February 1. This is also the application to use to apply for Cooperative Scholarship Housing on the Columbus campus (the Stadium Scholarship Program and Alumnae Scholarship Housing), which is based on need and merit.
