Safety Resources and How to Find Out About Them

The safety of the Ohio State community is the university's top priority. Ohio State works around the clock to enhance safety through patrols, lights, cameras and other technology. Some of the robust resources for the campus community include:

- The <u>Community Crime Map</u>, which uses statistics from the Columbus Division of Police and shows off-campus crime reports. Ohio State has preprogrammed the map to a one-mile radius to include the crime reports from the most recent 7-day period.
- The university offers several complimentary home and personal safety devices including personal safety alarms for students, light timers and window and door alarms.
- <u>Stay Safe, Buckeyes</u> is an online safety class that teaches students through scenario-based exercises and engaging videos. Students learn how to enhance their own safety on their own schedule.
- After 9 p.m., Campus Area Bus Service (CABS) On-Demand provides transportation between campus buildings. Students can download the Tripshot app to schedule a free ride.
- The university has extended the service areas, and hours, of our <u>discounted Lyft Ride Smart program</u>. A \$4 discount is offered to students between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m.

The university regularly communicates to the campus community – especially students – about safety. While many of our safety communications are open to parents, faculty and staff, some are targeted to students only. This includes text messages, phone app notifications, emails from the Office of Student Life, Department of Public Safety and other units, signage posted on campus, social media posts and advertisements, newsletters targeted toward students and more.

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Dennis Learning Center



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Know the Law, Learn Your Responsibilities, Prevent Hazing

As part of The Ohio State's University's commitment to promoting a safe and healthy campus environment, members of our community have the right to be free from all forms of hazing.

In accordance with the university's <u>Anti-Hazing</u> <u>Policy</u> and under Collin's Law, no administrator, employee, faculty member, teacher, consultant, alumnus or volunteer of any organization, shall recklessly permit the hazing of any person associated with an organization or fail to immediately report the knowledge of hazing.
